

Future Hawks Lacrosse Club

Who can play: Any 6th - 8th grade student who is currently zoned to attend Holly Springs High School. No previous lacrosse experience is necessary!

Who will we play: The Future Hawks will play in the Triangle Youth Lacrosse Conference (TYLC) against other middle school-aged teams in Wake County. You can find more information at http://tylclacrosse.com/

When will the season start and end: The season will begin in February and end with TYLC playoffs and all-star game in late April/early May. Games and practices will typically take place on weekdays.

Where will the team practice and play: We are currently securing fields, but the hope is that we will be able to utilize the multi-purpose fields at Holly Springs High School as well as the field behind Holly Ridge Middle/Elementary.

How much will this cost: The goal is to keep fees reasonable. Fields must be rented, we would like to pay coaches a small stipend, there is a small fee for league entry, and we must pay officials for all home games (we will use uniforms purchased last year and supplement if more are needed). Final costs will be determined ASAP, but expect the final amount to be in the \$75 to \$100 range. Our finances will be very transparent and will be made available to all parents - expenses will be split equally among all registered players. If you know of a local business that would like to help sponsor the team, fees can be lower. Please contact us with any sponsorship ideas.

Will this interfere with club lacrosse: The league and team are structured to allow players to continue to play club lacrosse. The Future Hawks Lacrosse Club is not affiliated with any club lacrosse program, although we anticipate many players from local clubs and organizations will join the team.

Who is coaching: We are working to secure a great coaching staff. It is our hope that some current HSHS players may drop in to help out with practices when possible.

Why are you doing this: This is an effort to allow lacrosse players who will be attending HSHS an opportunity to play together before they head off to high school. By keeping this affordable, we hope to be able to also introduce new players to the game. Eventually we would like to see this grow to allow each area middle school the opportunity to field a team in the TYLC.

What do I need to play: Regulation lacrosse equipment includes a NOCSAE certified helmet, mouth guard, arm pads, gloves, protective cup, shoulder pads and a stick. Unfortunately, at this time there is no loaner equipment available directly from the club, however, most players have extra gear they will lend. If you need equipment please let us know. You will also need an active US Lacrosse membership (\$30/year) for insurance purposes.
